Special thanks to the editors of the magazine PAT A MAT by appointing me as a judge of such an important event, and in particular to Ľuboš Kekely responsible of the section for studies, also to all participants of this tournament.

The Director sent me 21 studies for the evaluation, with diagrams and solutions, corresponding to 17 composers of 14 countries.

I preferred the original and solving friendly works. Of course, I considered the general evaluation criterias.

I found two anticipations and one mistake.

No. 603 (P. Arrestov) – anticipation, look at P. Krug, 2/3. sp. p. Solidarity ty (2012), A. Sochnev, 1. hm Szachy (1983). At least partial anticipation No. 58. (P. Arrestov) – see V. Kovalevko, Shakhmatnaya Kompozitsia (2005), The stalemate picture is identical. In the joint composition of Gurgenidze-Minski black wins after 3...Kc4! 4.d8Q Nd5+.



He pursues the black king from the king side to the queen side. The construction of the work was a big task. Despite its length, this is an interesting, solver-friendly study.







The side lines are valuable as well.

When the black promote his pawn to queen, then the position of white appears hopeless. However, the rook and the knight compensate the material disadvantage by a surprising battery. The end of the game is the capturing of the Queen or an perpetual threat.
